	When you take part in the supplier survey on the Business Partner Code of Conduct, we collect and process the following personal data from you:

IV.	Purpose of data processing
	We collect this personal data in order to identify you as a contact to our business partner so that we can ensure our business partner's adherence to the obligations of our Business Partner Code of Conduct.
V.	Legal basis for data processing
	The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is Article 6(1) sentence 1 lit b. of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) because, in the context of the survey, you are submitting a statement for your employer, our business partner, indicating that this business partner follows the Code of Conduct. This establishes a contractual obligation. In any case, we are authorized to process the data based on legitimate interests (Article 6(1) sentence 1 lit f. of the GDPR). We need this data to establish the legal relationship previously mentioned, identifying you as our contact to our business partner and communicating with you in this context.
VI.	Duration of processing
	We save your personal data collected and processed in connection with the supplier survey until the execution of a follow-up survey on the Business Partner Code of Conduct, however for a period of five (5) years at the longest, calculated from when the supplier survey is completed.
VII.	Recipient
	The personal data is not transferred to third parties under any circumstances.
VIII.	Your rights as the party concerned
	You have the following rights with respect to Aurubis AG: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may withdraw your consent that was given to us at any time (Article 7(3) of the GDPR). As a consequence, we may no longer continue with the data processing from that point on if it was based on this consent. This, on the other hand, can lead to the result that you are no longer permitted to enter our plant premises in Hamburg. • You have the right to request information regarding your personal data that is saved and processed by us (Article 15 of the GDPR). In particular, you can request information regarding the purposes of processing; the category of the personal data; the categories of recipients to whom your data was or will be disclosed; the intended storage period; the existence of a right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, or objection; the existence of a right to lodge a complaint; the source of your data, if it was not collected by us; as well as regarding the existence of automated decision-making (including profiling) and, if applicable, meaningful information regarding the details.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may request the prompt rectification or completion of your personal data stored by us (Article 16 of the GDPR). • You may request the erasure of your personal data that is stored by us if the processing of this data is not required to exercise the right to freedom of expression and information; to comply with a legal obligation; for reasons of public interest; or for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims (Article 17 of the GDPR). • You may request that we restrict the processing of your personal data if you contest the accuracy of the data; the processing is unlawful, but you oppose the erasure; we no longer need the data, but you need it for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims; or you have objected to the processing pursuant to Article 21 of the GDPR (Article 18 of the GDPR). • You have the right to receive the personal data that you have provided to Aurubis AG in a structured, conventional, and machine-readable format or to request the transmission of the data to another controller (right to data portability) (Article 20 of the GDPR). • You may complain to a supervisory authority. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority at your usual place of residence or work or at Aurubis AG's headquarters for this purpose (Article 77 of the GDPR).
IX.	Right of objection
