

Which internship vacancies are available?

Check our website <https://www.aurubis.com/beerse/career/jobs> where you can find an overview of all available internships. If you don't find an internship that matches your preferences, please send us your CV via 'spontaneous application' with an accompanying letter explaining why, where and when you would like to do an internship with us. Also make sure to mention the duration and conditions of your internship assignment. You can use the document 'internship application' which can be found in the download area. We welcome students for all kinds of internships, from a short internship of three days (browsing work placements) to an internship of several months and even years through projects with universities.

Which study programmes are eligible for an internship at Aurubis Beerse?

We offer internships for students with a variety of study backgrounds, ranging from secondary to doctoral, but we are also open to other types of internships as long as they are legally permitted. We have already gained experience in assisting students specialized in metallurgy, (chemical) process techniques, automation, electro-mechanics, logistics, finance, communication, legal, human resources, lab, and sales marketing.

Can I make my final thesis or master thesis in cooperation with Aurubis Beerse?

Can I combine my GIP (Integrated Test) with an internship?

We offer various internships for students from different fields of secondary education. It is possible to combine the internship with a GIP. In this way, as a student, you can get to know our company in advance and discuss your GIP. During your internship you can then elaborate even more deeply on the various elements of your GIP.

Is it possible to do an internship abroad?

This is only possible, we have several sites across Europe and in the USA. It all depends on the local legal requirements and the type of internship that your school does provide you.

Do I need to be connected to a school or university for an internship?

You must be registered at a school, college or university for the entire duration of your internship. Unless you are registered as unemployed and you are doing an internship via VDAB or another supporting non-profit organization.

Do I need to have friends or family at Aurubis Beerse to qualify for an internship?

No. We do expect you to meet the desired (educational) conditions and to have the right mindset.

How can I apply for an internship?

What steps do I need to take in order to do an internship?

After we have received your CV and information, you will receive an invitation for an interview or a rejection if you do not meet the internship requirements.

During the introductory interview, we will discuss our expectations and your objectives for the internship. You will be given the opportunity to ask questions, therefore it would be nice if you could prepare yourself. Based on the interview and the internship positions and/or available internal supervisor, we will then decide whether or not to award you an internship position.

If we offer you an internship placement, we will contact you again to arrange the necessary paperwork and, if necessary, the medical examination.

Can I reach Aurubis Beerse by public transport?

- 45 minutes from Hasselt or Lier
- 12 minutes from Turnhout

Where should I apply for a job interview at Aurubis Beerse?

For a job interview at Aurubis Beerse, you must always present yourself at Vaartstraat 59 in Beerse at the North entrance (on the side of the canal – so not at the side where the trucks have to register).

Note: except if stated otherwise in the e-mail confirmation.

Do you offer paid internships?

Most of the internships are unpaid unless it is to achieve your PhD via one of the universities with whom we have a partnership.
